Belgium leads after Day 1

With two wins from their first two games Belgium has taken the lead at the European Curling Championships C-Group 2014 in Zoetermeer, the Netherlands. It's joined by Ireland and Slovenia who also won both their matches on the first day of competition. Luxembourg is also still unbeaten, but only played one game today. After losing their first game at an international tournament, Israel got their historic first win against Belarus in the night session.

Women

Spain won the first game in the women's competition against Romania with a big margin, while Slovakia proved to be too strong for Ireland. The home team, The Netherlands, had to shake off some nerves, but got right back in the game with a score of five in the third end. But ultimately it was Slovenia who took the win, when the final Dutch stone came up just short in an effort to force an extra end.
